



Chimp Management





Following the success of our session with Tim Buckle from Chimp Management as part of our Trust training day last year, we are delighted to welcome Tim back to Melrose Learning Trust in February for further work with our staff and pupils in regards to managing the mind more effectively.

Tim will be spending time in each of our schools to work with pupils to introduce the Chimp Model and to help them better understand and manage emotions, thinking and behaviour. Tim will then deliver a training session for staff with two key aims. Firstly, focussing on staff's own wellbeing and secondly, understanding how the Chimp Model can be used to better to support pupils in school.
